Background of Workshop

The National Education Policy (NEP), 2020 emphasizes the revival and integration of Bharatiya Jñāna Paramparā (Indian Knowledge Systems - IKS) within the academic and cultural framework of India. This proposal aims to organize a 7-day interdisciplinary workshop that will explore and examine India's rich epistemological traditions through various dimensions Philosophy, science, art, culture, agriculture, literature, medicine, astronomy, economics, logic, administration, psychology, and ethics.

By integration of IKS with NEP-2020's vision, this workshop will facilitate a scholarly platform where academicians, researchers and students will engage in critical dialogue with India's ancient and modern intellectual traditions. This initiative will not only bridge the gap between classical and contemporary knowledge systems but also revive indigenous knowledge for national academic rejuvenation.

Objectives of the Workshop

- Introduce and analyze the epistemological foundations of Indian philosophical traditions (Darśanas).
- Highlight India's rich contributions to science, medicine and technology.
- Explore the relevance of Indian ethics, logic and psychology to contemporary disciplines.
- Revisit Gurukula and holistic learning models in Indian education.
- Understanding how art, culture and literature shaped India's civilizational ethos.
- Promote interdisciplinary methodologies for curriculum integration.
- Develop actionable insights for implementing NEP 2020 through IKS.
